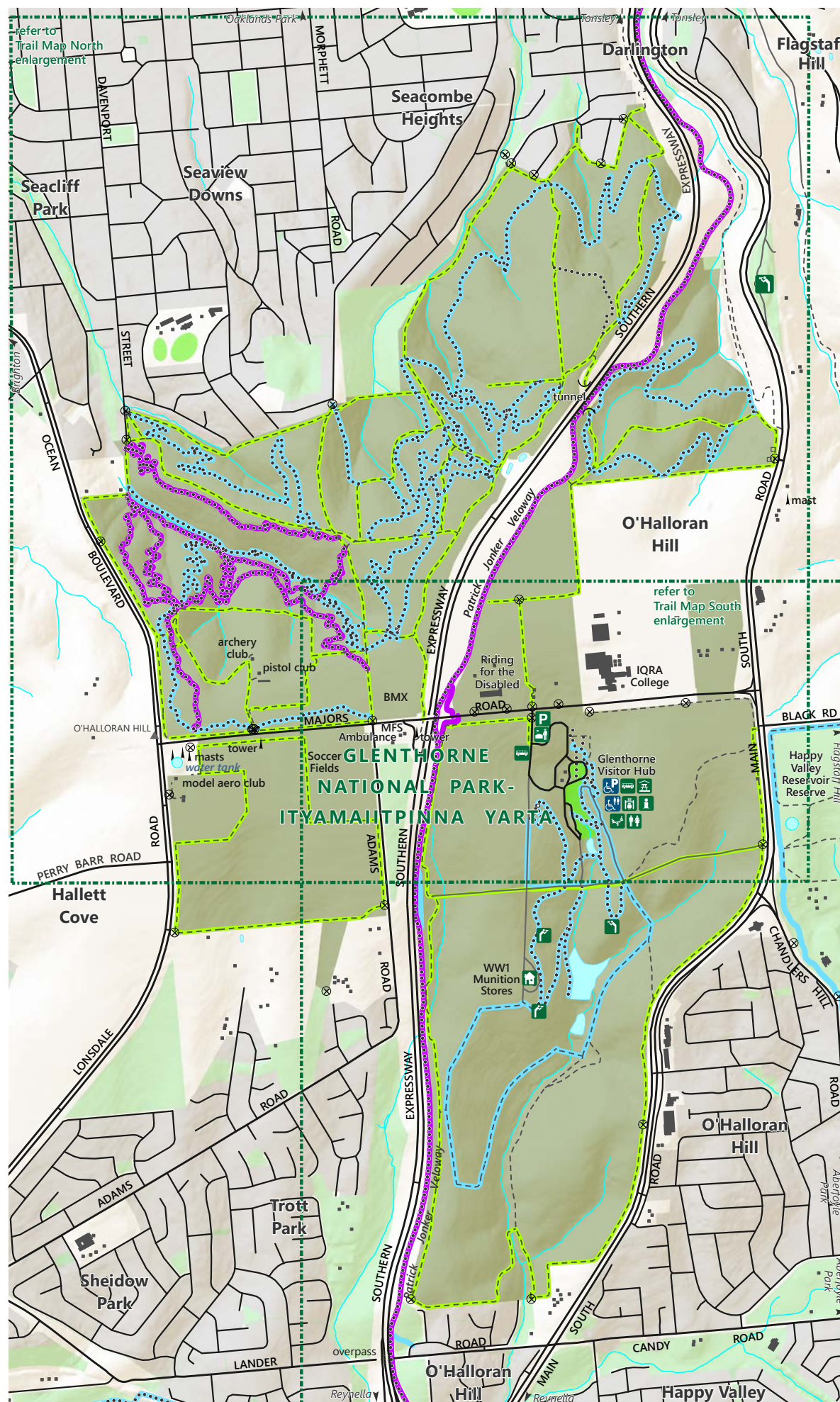

Horse Riding
