
Ngarkat Conservation Park

Orchid Hike







The Mallee is full of surprises. Small, delicate, and beautiful Ngarkat Conservation Park is home to over 50 orchid species which blooms during late autumn to spring. Become an orchid-hunter and seek out their colourful flowers as you walk through this native pine woodland but please don't pick them, only take photos.

Trail name	Trail class	Distance/ Time	Trail description
Orchid Hike	Grade 3 Moderate hike	2 km, 40 mins return	Suitable for most ages and fitness levels. The hike will take you through native pine woodland supporting a variety of orchids. There will be some short steep sections and uneven surfaces. Some bushwalking experience is recommended. Trail markers guide the way.
*Hikers can estimate the time required to walk a trail by using an average speed of 3 to 4 km per hour.			



Do not leave the track. The uniform vegetation and lack of readily identifiable features make it easy to become disorientated. Follow the installed trail markers.
